

MAINTENANCE

MINUTE

Hello Residents of Crestwood Village 1,

Happy Spring Village 1!

Total Work Orders (past 30 days) = 229

Throughout Crestwood Village 1, the Maintenance Department has come across many issues regarding the use of SharkBite plumbing fittings. These are "push-to-connect" plumbing fittings used to attach water supply lines together. The issues we have come across are major leaks in the interior of buildings, resulting in damage to subfloors, cabinets and vanities. Other issues include multiple SharkBite fittings leaking in crawlspaces, which creates a potentially hazardous situation with excess water and moisture...not to mention these fittings are located on supply lines, which will result in increases to your water bill.

The benefits to the SharkBite is the speed and durability in which they can be installed and allows the non-plumber the ability to attempt to make these connections. The negatives to the SharkBite when speaking to most professional plumbers, they will only use these as a last resort, an emergency fix and not part of a permanent or enclosed plumbing system. There are concerns regarding their long term durability and high potential for leaks, which we have experienced first-hand. The fittings are susceptible to cold and will lead to problems if not installed correctly. They rely on an O-ring and locking mechanism, which has been proven to not withstand the test of time, when compared to traditional methods.

To that end, the Crestwood Village Co-op has voted and elected that the use of these SharkBite fittings are no longer permitted in Village 1. You, the resident, will have to make sure the plumber you hire will not use these fittings and if they are observed during a post-construction inspection, you will be responsible for hiring or contacting the plumber so they can use an alternative method of connecting water lines. Whether that means using the appropriate PEX crimp connection, compression fittings or the tried and true method of soldering when available. This is in an attempt to protect the buildings structure and integrity, as again, we've seen several occasions where these SharkBite fittings have failed and caused significant damage.

At any point in time that the Maintenance Department comes across these SharkBite fittings, the resident will receive a letter stating the fittings need to be replaced. You will be given 30 days to remedy the situation. An inspection will be completed after these 30 days and if the work is not done, the Crestwood Village Co-op will hire a plumber to correct the situation and you will be charged accordingly.

MANCHESTER COORDINATING COUNCIL

The MCC monthly meeting was held on Monday, February 25, 2025 at Village 5 Clubhouse, Schoolhouse Rd, Whiting, NJ.

Mayor Joseph Hankins welcomed Senator Carmen Amato Jr., Brian Rumpf, and Greg Myhre. A team of JCPL directors, managers, and team members gave a presentation to explain and discuss the recent power outage Whiting experienced.

Chris Koenig of JCPL Communications explained that on 12/23/24:

- One of two transformer banks was out of service due to maintenance, creating abnormal operating conditions. A trip (fault condition) resulted in an outage affecting the remaining in-service bank. Transformer bank # 1 lost power
- Restoration impacted by cold temperatures ("cold loading")
- Forced outage taken a week later to connect mobile substation
- Actions taken: Mobile substation installed to replace Bank # 2 until maintenance is completed
 - Circuit patrols completed and reliability engineer assessment performed. Six Circuits
 - 50 reliability items to be designed/scheduled/constructed in 2025
 - Work includes additional fusing installs, equipment replacement, and fault additions
 - Thermography patrols to be scheduled and completed in February 2025

Call 800-662-3115, and a specialist will determine whether you qualify for a budget billing/equal payment plan or assistance programs. Senator Amato states he is working with Mayor Hankins to organize and host a seminar on ways to get rates down and update energy aggregation in the next few weeks.

There is no correlation between smart meters and increased electric consumption and bills. Smart meters are state-of-the-art technology to ensure accurate readings. Meter pinging enhances the efficiency of the storm restoration process, resulting in more accurate billing by reducing estimated bills.

External market rate factors, supply, and demand, are the major reasons for the 20% increase. NJ's increase in consumption and decrease in the number of power plants online means we must import about 20% of the electricity used.

Ciba-Geigy update was given: In the last court case, not all info was reviewed, so the case was appealed, which is a big win in court.

The next meeting, which will be held on **Monday, March 24, 2025**, features Melissa from Senior Services, Manchester Parks, and Somebody Cares.

The meeting adjourned at 2:30 PM.




