- Kwanzaa is a modern African-American and pan-African holiday that was established in 1966 by Dr.
 Maulana Karenga, a professor studies. Beginning on 26th December and ending on 1st January,
 Kwanzaa is a cultural festival celebrating African culture and community.
- Bodhi Day is celebrated annually on 8th of December and is a Buddhist holiday celebrating the
 enlightenment of Siddhartha Gautama, the historical Buddha. Buddhists commemorate the day that
 Gautama completed his meditation beneath the Bodhi tree. Upon awakening, Gautama is said to
 have had a number of profound realizations, which became the founding principles of Buddhism.

So no matter what holiday or festival you celebrate, Happy Holidays and enjoy.

Holiday Greetings from the Village 1 Maintenance Department!

Total Work Orders (past 30 days) = 311

This month I will go over the snow removal procedures for Village 1. This is a very important topic that everyone needs to be aware of. If you ever need clarification or have any questions regarding the snow removal procedure please contact the Maintenance Department or the Trustees Office. On days of snow removal, the phones at the Maintenance Department will not be answered directly. Please leave a message and someone will return your call at our earliest availability. Snow stakes have been installed, please do not remove or move these stakes as they are positioned to help the plow drivers navigate around potential hazards.


Please see below for Crestwood Village 1's snow clearing guidelines. The information provided below comes directly from the Board of Trustees. The biggest thing we can request is that all residents stay inside when the street and driveway clearing is underway and to please exercise patience and understanding during these times. Special consideration for priority snow removal will only be arranged for medical appointments and outpatient treatments. You are required to provide the Trustee's Office a copy of your doctor's name, phone number and time of your appointment on your respective doctor's letterhead. This must be provided in advance, we will not be able to accommodate calls made the morning of a snow storm. After verifying the information provided, the Board of Trustees and the Trustees Office will prioritize the clearing of these units. The Board of Trustees will not make special arrangements for those that are employed, it will not entitle you to priority snow removal. Please do not call the Maintenance Department to request individual attention, the only ones that can authorize priority snow plowing are the Trustees.

- 1. Roads will not be plowed until there is around 3" of snow accumulation across the Village;
- **2.** When icy conditions are present, ice melt will be applied to the roads;

- 3. NO on-street parking is allowed for impending snow, you will be assessed a \$50 fine and parking on the grass is not acceptable. If you do leave your vehicle on the grass or road during plowing activities, you will be plowed in. If you require assistance to get your vehicle out, you will be charged a minimum of \$60 for the service and will not be addressed until all other snow clearing activities are completed;
- **4.** Residents are not to push, shovel, blow or deposit snow onto Village roadways;
- **5.** When the roads are made passable, the Maintenance Department will begin to clear driveways, then followed by sidewalks;
- **6.** Duplex driveways will be cleared and treated as sidewalks, as you do have secondary means to exit and enter the building through your garage door;
- 7. Quad driveways will be cleared by pushing the snow forward towards the buildings or to the side when available, depending on the positioning of your building;
- **8.** Sidewalks will be cleared as soon as possible, depending on the man-power that is available and after roads and driveways are cleared;
- 9. Keep a bag or two of ice melt on hand for your steps and sidewalk area (available through the Maintenance Department, call for pricing and for delivery). The snow melt provided by the Maintenance Department is not advertised as animal friendly;
- **10.**THERE WILL BE NO DEVIATION FROM OUR SNOW REMOVAL PROGRAM.

Thank you in advance for your cooperation! Hope everyone stays warm and safe during these winter months ahead!



Holiday Images

It's time to prepare for the holidays - Christmas, Hanukkah, and New Years. The main subjects are family and friends. I run this article every December because I think this is a good time for a review.

This time of year we often see relatives and loved ones that we haven't seen for a while. We want to capture the festive atmosphere and good time that everyone is enjoying. What can we do to make these images look relaxed and more professional?

For candid shots make certain you're prepared -- have your camera ready and watch the subject for the expression you want. If you aren't ready the shot will be gone before you press the shutter. Most holiday shots will be taken indoors so don't forget to use your camera's flash.

For portraits and group shots get yourself set up first, and then prepare your subject. If you keep them waiting you will not get a natural relaxed image. For individual portraits choose a background that's festive,

but not too busy. Have your subject(s) turn their shoulders slightly so they are not too square to the camera.

When photographing grandchildren or pets try to get eye level with them, rather than shooting down at them.

I also like to photograph the festive holiday decorations. These often make fun shots and can be used on your holiday cards next year.

Don't forget the rule of



thirds (also from a previous photo tip). Rather than placing your subjects in front of the Christmas tree, move them slightly to one side. If shooting the dinner table set for the holiday feast, have the host stand at one side of the table about 1/3 of the way from the end, rather than centered at the end of the table.

These techniques will help improve your images holiday images. Have a great holiday season, a happy and healthy New Year and remember to have fun with your camera.






