Hello Village 1 Residents!

Total Work Orders Completed (past 30 working days) = 216

This month I would like to discuss the use of drain cleaners when trying to deal with either a slow draining or completely backed up sink or bathtub and the use of flushable wipes.

The commercially purchased drain cleaners (Liquid Plumber, Drano, Green Gobbler, Liquid Power, etc.) are very caustic and have the potential to injure the Maintenance workers. I know purchasing one of these commercial cleaners is a cheaper alternative, but the Maintenance Department has the ability to correct any clogs without the use of these cleaners. If you are a do-it vourselfer, please consider a less dangerous alternative. I recently had a backup in my kitchen sink at home and after exhausting numerous do it yourself options, I had to call a commercial company to come and service my plumbing. After working to eliminate the clog, the technician told me "when in doubt, melt it out". As he explained to me, just about everything you put down the drain will eventually back-up the plumbing...soap, shampoo/conditioner, food and especially grease. What he meant by letting it melt out, was to run super-hot water once a month or as needed, to a point where the hot water heater tank almost runs empty and that should help to eliminate the build-up of the stuff that can and will cause clogs over time.

Please see below for a picture showing how destructive these products can be, this is or was a pair of jeans...maybe we can sell them since horribly ripped jeans seem to be the new fashion trend. Besides just clothing getting destroyed, this causes serious chemical burns to skin and thankfully we haven't had an issue with any coming in contact with eyes.





If you do use anything besides water to try and eliminate the clogged plumbing, PLEASE tell the Maintenance Department what was used and how much so we can properly prepare to service the lines. Every once in a while, the clogged plumbing is

so bad that the Maintenance Department actually has to remove a portion of the drain pipe because everything basically solidified, not allowing any water to pass. Also remember that all the plumbing in your building, with 2 or 4 units, does share a common mail plumbing line. All we can do is ask that people avoid sending stuff down the drains as much as possible and that everyone does their part to try and keep the plumbing systems running smoothly.

Flushable Wipes/Plumbing

Believe it or not, this topic has been thrust into the forefront due to several recent issues the Village has been experiencing. On several occasions, our main sanitary sewers have become packed solid to a point where the sewage has actually come out the manhole covers located in the streets and/or have backed up into buildings with the same. The biggest culprit? Glad you asked, it is toilet wipes...flushable, non-flushable, septic and sewer safe, paper towels and anything else that is out there as a commercial product. These items do not break down like toilet paper as advertised and it will travel down the sanitary sewer and before long we have a major issue as soon as it gets caught up and no water is able to pass through. You have to try and remember that these sewers and plumbing in most cases under the buildings are nearly 60 years old. The Maintenance Department will be the first to try to eliminate the clog, but if there is a substantial blockage, the Village has to contact an outside contractor and this will typically cost the Village almost \$600 per occurrence for them to come out and service.

There are times where it is simply a blockage, but if the Maintenance Department or one of the services identifies wipes as the cause of the blockage, the Board of Trustees has voted to make this chargeable back to the resident. There are some instances where it is very obvious which resident is responsible for flushing the wipes. Repeat offenders will be fined and might be expected to pay not only for any repairs, but the cost for the outside contractor as well. If there is an entire building and the culprit cannot be identified, then potentially the cost for repairs and the outside contractor can be split evenly between the number of units occupying the building.

THE FLUSHING OF FLUSHABLE, NON-FLUSHABLE, SEPTIC AND SEWER SAFE WIPES AND PAPER TOWELS IS NO LONGER PERMITTED IN CRESTWOOD VILLAGE 1. IF YOU MUST USE WIPES OF ANY VARIETY MUST BE THROWN OUT WITH YOUR HOUSEHOLD TRASH. THE ONLY THING THAT CAN BE FLUSHED IS TOILET PAPER.

When are ticks active and how do tick-borne diseases spread?

Ticks could be active year round with peak times being May, June and July.

Tick-borne diseases are not spread between two people, but rather rely on ticks for transmission.

What are the symptoms of tick-borne diseases?

Early signs of tick-borne diseases generally include:

Skin rash, general tiredness, fever and/or chills, headache, stiff neck, muscle aches, joint pain, dizziness.

How are tick-borne diseases diagnosed?

It is important to watch for symptoms, talk to your healthcare provider and be sure to let them know you had a tick bite. If you've been bitten by a tick, early treatment can be very effective.

How can tick-borne diseases be prevented?

Anyone who is bitten by an infected tick may get a tick-borne disease. Helpful hints include:

- Take extra precautions in the summer when ticks that transmit diseases are most active
- When outdoors, apply EPA-registered insect repellent on exposed skin and clothing according to the instructions on the product label. Products containing DEET, picaridin or oil of lemon Eucalyptus may be used on skin. Permethrin containing products should only be used on clothing and outdoor gear Cover up; wear long, solid and light colored clothing with pants tucked into socks
