MANCHESTER COORDINATING COUNCIL

The MCC monthly meeting was held on Monday, November 24, 2025
at Village 5 Clubhouse, Schoolhouse Rd, Whiting, NJ.

Salute to our American flag and a moment of silence.

Kathleen Cullinen from the Department of Family and Community Health Services, Coop Extension of Ocean County, Rutgers State University, was introduced and provided tips to beat the Holiday Blues.

Social isolation and loneliness is an important public health concern. Loneliness is associated with an increased risk of heart disease, dementia, stroke, anxiety, and depression. Social connection is linked to increased longevity and better social, emotional, and physical well-being.

Sample risk factors include living alone or being unable to leave your home, feeling alone or disconnected from others, recently experiencing a major loss or change, being a caregiver, and lacking a sense of purpose.

Prevention tips: schedule daily time to stay in touch with someone, attend community events and programs, engage in classes and lectures, and volunteer your time.

Signs of depression include persistent sad, anxious, or empty mood; feelings of hopelessness, guilt, or helplessness; loss of interest; decreased energy; and moving or talking slowly.

They announced they will be starting an ALZ/DEM caregiver series of workshops. This disease is increasing globally, affecting people even in their 40s and, in rare cases, children.

There are many opportunities for seniors in Ocean County—stay connected, chair yoga, bingo, holiday functions at clubhouses. It's important to remain engaged. The Healthy Aging Initiative of the Ocean County Office of Senior Services helps make Ocean County a supportive place for people to age in place with a good quality of life.

Manchester Township OEM Coordinator Sgt. Robert Sharry was introduced. He has been a police officer in Manchester for over 28 years. As our OEM Coordinator, he is the liaison between the Police, Fire, First Aid, governing body in Town, County, and State organizations—any organization involved during an emergency.

In the near future, the State Forest Fire Service will be maintaining the wildlife interface areas. In 2023, we updated our Wildfire Protection Plan and identified areas around town that need remediation, such as overgrown grass and brush. This is a 10-year project. They will schedule remediation and controlled burns, beginning in late January or early February. Controlled burns are done in winter when the ground is wet so fires do not spread out of control. The window is small—after April 15, the weather becomes too warm. In spring and summer, the Forest Fire Service is busy responding to fires; in fall and winter, they work on preventative projects.

Judy, MCC Legislative Chairwoman, distributed a State of New Jersey synopsis requiring county recording officers to establish a property alert service to notify participating property owners of the recording of certain documents that affect property (introduced October 27, 2025).

Judy Noonan was presented with flowers and a donation to "Somebody Cares" in her name, thanking her for all she does for our entire senior community.

MINUTE

Happy New Year! Welcome to 2026 and I hope it's a safe and healthy year for everyone!

Total Work Orders (past 30 days) = 168

Winter Travel

If you will be traveling during the winter months, please make sure you are taking the proper precautions to secure your property. This definitely includes your outside furniture and belongings, as many of you know, Village 1 can turn into a bit of a wind tunnel during these months and has been known to relocate these items. Additionally, the interior of your unit should be prepared for extended travel. If leaving for a week or two, please ensure your heat is on to the unit. It does not need to be at 70° F, but thermostats should be set for a minimum of 55° F, and any cabinetry with plumbing should be left open to allow the heated air in to prevent potential pipe freeze-ups. Maybe you plan on being away for longer than that, you may want to consider winterizing your unit. Crestwood Village 1 Co-op (Co-op) provides this service for \$150.00, in which the Maintenance Department will drain the water to the unit, add a non-toxic RV antifreeze to the plumbing lines and turn off all the electric or some residents choose to leave the heat on or the refrigerator running. The \$150.00 charge includes winterizing and de-winterizing, where the water and electric are restored to the unit and plumbing lines are flushed removing the residual non-toxic antifreeze.

This is very important for residents to consider because the alternative is potentially coming back to a major water issue in your unit, which you will be solely responsible for the cost and work needed to restore the damage to your unit and any other areas of the building affected by the water. If you are winterized, the Co-op will assume responsibility for the unlikely event something fails in the unit while winterized.

Keys

This is a pretty big deal. Please make sure you provide a new key or updated key to the Maintenance Department. If it is as simple as accidentally locking yourself out of your unit we can provide access with the provided key to prevent additional charges as a result of having to break a lock off and replace it. The Maintenance Department will never access a unit without prior approval from the resident. In the unlikely event, that there is a medical issue or emergency, the Maintenance Department would provide access to emergency personal to again, prevent additional costs to repair a door or window that was used for access to the building.

Update Contact Info

Please provide the Maintenance Department or the Trustees Office with updated contact information as it becomes available. I don't know what you guys are doing out there, but I've never seen so many changing telephone numbers! We rely on this information to provide updates across the Village and to contact individual homeowners to let them know a project will be starting soon or updates. Or we sometimes have a resident contact us and will either leave a name or just an address on the answering machine and we have to do a reverse search to find a telephone contact that might not work and we can't reach back out to the resident leaving the message. This is also important for additional contacts. Work cannot be completed unless authorized by the certificate holder or a family/friend that has been named by the Courts to be their Power of Attorney.

Updating this information and providing new keys can be the difference in avoiding a potential issue where time is of the essence.

Crock Pot Lentil Stew



Ingredients:

- 1 bag dry brown lentils [rinsed and sorted]
- 1 large onion chopped, 2 stalks celery chopped large, 3 carrots 1" sliced
- 3-4 [Idaho, Russet, or Red] unpeeled potatoes - cut into large cubes
- 1 pound meat [beef or lamb shank, stew beef or cut up chuck steak]
- 1 ½ tsp salt, 1 ½ tsp cumin, 1-2 tsp *Better Than Bullion* brand broth starter [beef or vegetable flavor]
- 5-6 cups water
- 1 bag fresh spinach, greens or, 1 head Escarole cut

Directions:

Place all ingredients *except for greens* into crock pot. Cook on High for approx. 4 hours, stirring occasionally. Add the Greens, and cook for 1 more hour.

It is ready when the lentils are tender and begin to lose their shape. *Keep an eye on the liquid, this is a stew, not a soup consistency.

Serve with cornbread or any other hearty bread.

Snowy Images

The cold weather makes it hard to get motivated to go outdoors and shoot, but there are some great photo opportunities to be had in winter. Make certain you dress for the cold and watch for ice!

Even when there is no snow, icy ponds make great subjects. Look for ducks, geese, or seagulls standing on the ice. Ice makes for great reflection images. Many normal scenes take on a new meaning in winter.

After a snowfall, there are great shots everywhere. The challenge with snow shots is getting the proper exposure. A bright snowy scene tricks your camera into thinking there is too much light, so the camera will cut back on exposure. This makes the snow in your images look gray. If you know how to set your exposure compensation, increase the exposure by 1 stop to brighten the snow. If your camera has "scene" modes, use the one for snow or beach.

The bare leafless trees make nice silhouette shots and are very good for black and white photography. They are

especially effective with a sunrise or sunset behind them.


